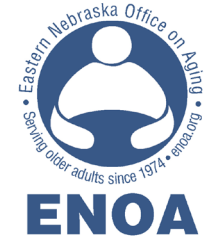

The Emergency Response System is a twenty-four hour service that summons help for an individual in an emergency.

The ERS unit is hooked up through the clients landline phone. Clients will receive a neck pendant or a wrist pendant to use in case of emergency. Simply push the help button at any time to connect with the 24/7 Response Center. Then the client's chosen emergency contact will be notified.

The monthly monitoring fee is on a sliding scale and is based on the clients ability to pay.

Eligibility

Any person age 60 or older who resides in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington counties that meets Care Management and income guidelines and has a landline telephone.
