The Emergency Response System is a twenty-four hour service that summons help for an individual in an emergency.

The ERS unit is hooked up through the clients landline phone, a cellular mobile unit is also available. Clients will receive a neck pendant or a wrist pendant to use in case of emergency. Simply push the help button at any time to connect with the 24/7 Response Center. Then the client's chosen emergency contact will be notified.

The cost of the service is a contribution based on a sliding fee scale according to your monthly income. You never give money to the provider; tipping is not allowed.

Eligibility

Any person age 60 or older who resides in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington counties that meets Care Management and income guidelines and has a telephone.
