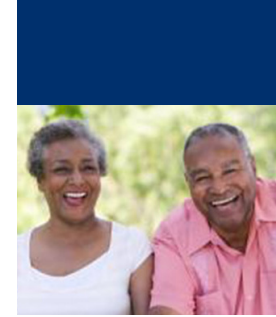

What a homemaker can do...

- Carry out trash
- Change bed linens/make bed
- Clean the bathroom
- Clean the bedroom
- Clean range
- Clean refrigerator
- Dust
- Grocery shopping
- Ironing
- Laundry (home/laundromat)
- Mopping floor with mop
- Prepare food
- Vacuum floors
- Wash dishes/load & unload dishwasher
- Wash mirrors



Program Guidelines

• Who is eligible?

Clients may reside in any of our five counties and must be at least 60 years of age and must meet Care Management criteria.

• How do I pay?

The cost of the service is a contribution based on a sliding fee scale according to your monthly income.

You never give money to the provider; tipping is not allowed.

- All cleaning tools & supplies are provided by the client.

We encourage clients to speak to their homemaker providers about cleaning products that they would suggest you have on hand.

Some suggested cleaning supplies include:

- Vacuum
- Broom and dust pan
- Mop (and bucket if necessary)
- Glass cleaner
- All-purpose cleaning spray (disinfecting)
- Bathtub scrubbing product
- Toilet bowl cleaner and toilet brush
- Scrubbing sponges
- Paper towels/rags
- Duster
- Laundry soap
- Dish soap/Dishwasher detergent
- Trash bags
