Yard Waste Regulations Have Changed in Omaha

With new methods of trash collection in the city, there are new rules and regulations regarding yard waste. Starting in the spring of 2021, for six weeks each spring and six weeks each fall, the city will collect yard waste to be composted. The schedule for these six week periods will be announced through the media and through the website wasteline.org.

So, what should yard work volunteers do with their clients' yard waste when those time periods are not in effect?

Yard waste that can fit into the clients' new trash bin will be collected with the trash, with no fee.

The city is selling \$1.98 stickers that must be placed on each bag or bundle of yard waste outside the new bins. There is no limit if all of the bags/bundles are tagged. The tagged yard waste will be collected with the new trash carts on the clients' usual trash day. There are instructions on the stickers about how and where they should be placed.

The \$1.98 stickers will be sold at most HyVee and Family Fare grocery store locations; Supermercado locations; Westlake and Ideal Hardware; and at Menards. A full list of locations is at www.wasteline.org/yardwaste-sticker-locations/
